<b>Immunogen</b>	KKPEGPRSHQHK, is from C Terminus
<b>Applications</b>	Pep ELISA Species Tested:
<b>Purification</b>	Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.
<b>Supplied As</b>	lyophilized powder of 50ug or 100ug IgG; Reconstitute IgG with 100ul or 200ul sterile DI Water and final product will be formulated as 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin. Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.
<b>Peptide ELISA</b>	Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1 to 128000.
<b>Western Blot</b>	Western Blot: Preliminary experiments gave an approx 22kDa band in lysates of cell lines HeLa and Jurkat after 0.5µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calcul
