Preparation	This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells from a mouse immunized with human recombinant protein of Integrin αV (also called CD51))
Formulation and Storage	The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.
Specificity	This antibody was selected for its ability to detect human Integrin αV.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute the antibody with 200 µl sterile PBS and the final concentration is 500 µg/ml. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquoted and stored frozen at < -20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Shipping	Regular FEDEX overnight shipment (ambient temperature)
