Preparation	This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells) from a mouse immunized with recombinant human HOMER1. HOMER1 is an 48kDa cytoplasmic protein that regulates the cell surface localization of neuronal mGluR1 and mGluR5 met
Formulation and Storage	The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.
Specificity	This antibody recognizes human HOMER1 in direct ELISAs and WBs. It cross reacts with mouse and rat HOMER1 in WBs.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute the antibody with 500µl sterile PBS and the final concentration is 200µg/ml. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquoted and stored frozen at < -20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
