Preparation: This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells) from a mouse immunized with recombinant human MARCH8. MARCH8 (membrane-associated RING-CH VIII) is also called MIR (modulator of immune recognition), or RNF178 (ring finger 178) and is a 33kDa two-pass transmembrane protein of lysosomal and early endosomal membranes in the MARCH family.

Formulation and Storage: The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.

Reconstitution: Reconstitute the antibody with 500ul sterile PBS and the final concentration is 200ug/ml. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquoted and stored frozen at < -20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. **Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.**

Specificity: This antibody recognizes human MARCH8 in direct ELISAs and WBs. It cross reacts with mouse and rat MARCH8 in WBs.
