

## Methionine Sulfoxide Reductase B E.Coli Recombinant

<b>Synonyms</b>	Peptide methionine sulfoxide reductase MsrB, Peptide-methionine (R)-S-oxide reductase, msrB, yeaA, b1778, JW1767.
<b>Description</b>	MSRB produced in E.Coli is a single, non-glycosylated polypeptide chain containing 157 amino acids (1-137 a.a.) and having a molecular mass of 17.6kDa. MSRB is fused to a 20 amino acid His-tag at N-terminus & purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques.

<b>Source</b>	Escherichia Coli.
<b>Physical Appearance and Stability</b>	Sterile filtered colorless solution. Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Formulation and Purity</b>	MSRB protein solution (1mg/ml) 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH8.0), 20% glycerol 0.1M NaCl and 1mM DTT. Greater than 95.0% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
