Description	Recombinant Protein-A/G/L produced in E.Coli is a single non-glycosylated polypeptide chain. Protein- A/ G/L is comprised of 5 IgG-binding regions of Protein A (E-D-A-B-C), 2 of protein G (C1-C3) and 5 of Protein L (B1-B2-B3-B4-B5) containing 805 amino acids in total and having a molecular mass of 89.2kDa. Physical Appearance and Stability	Sterile Filtered White lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder. Lyophilized Protein-A/G/L although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18°C. Upon reconstitution Protein-A/G/L should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18°C. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA).
Formulation and Purity	Protein- A/G/L was lyophilized without any additives. Greater than 95.0% as determined by: (a) Analysis by SEC-HPLC.(b) Analysis by SDS-PAGE.

Solubility	It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Protein-A/G/L in sterile 18M-cm H ₂ O not less than 0.1mg/ ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
Biological Activity	
Shipping Format and Condition	Lyophilized powder at room temperature.
